



# Liberty Rotary Club Individual Membership Dues



## Monthly Cost

**\$61.17** (Billed quarterly) This amount includes the following:

### Annual Dues

District 6040

\$ 22 District administration and expenses.

Rotary International

\$ 62 Cost of Rotarian magazine, liability insurance for the club, and Rotary International Dues. The balance supports various RI programs.

Local Charitable Giving

\$130 \$100 currently goes towards two 4 year scholarships worth \$4,000 and a one time \$1,500 scholarships. Students from the Liberty High School District, not related to Rotarians, are eligible. The additional \$30 may be given to the Rotary International Foundations or the clubs local foundation. Club total contribution totals approximately \$ 9,500.

Meals (52 @ \$10.00)

\$520 We do not charge any club dues so minor profit from lunch and missed lunch attendance are credited to charitable giving. Available funds for giving are about \$10,000. Hillcrest Transitional Housing, Meals on Wheels, Shepard Youth Center, Rotary Youth Leadership Academy, Rotary Youth Exchange, Freedom House and, Rebuild Liberty are some of the charities supported by the club.

Fines and Happy Dollars go to our local Foundation or RI Foundation needs.

## Expectations

Attendance – Rotary International and Liberty Rotary Club encourage and *recognize perfect attendance*. Officially 50% attendance is required. **Visiting other Rotary Clubs and E-Club make ups can be fun and educational and allow Rotarians to meet the attendance requirement. Make ups will credit your account for the weekly meal missed at Liberty Rotary.**
